

The 7 Muppetproof Money Methods for Non-Tech Newbies



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Introduction: Are you struggling to make money online? I have made over 7 million online. But it wasn't always easy. For two years I made zip.

It is definitely more fun on this end. Making all the money I want and living life on my own terms. And I hated the struggle. Though the pain is what made the victory so great.

I thought you'd like to skip some of that no money time. Skip some of the pain and get to the money right away instead. Don't be mad if you make money too quickly.

So, to get you started making money right away (without the two-year struggle), I have put together The 7 Muppetproof Money Methods for Non-Tech Newbies.





Blogging – Now this may sound technical, but it really is not. If you have the skills to write an email you can write a BLOG. Sure, it is a long email, around 2,000 words, but you can do it. I use WordPress to host my blog. If you get hosting [here](#), you will be able to get it installed free. A free WordPress Plugin called YOAST can help you get Googles attention. You get paid when you show ads or recommend affiliate products. When you get some traffic, you can use Google Adsense to get money for your site. You can recommend tools and products you use. It is really wise to collect email addresses so you can market to them on demand.



YouTube – This can be dead easy as well. You don't need special equipment. Lots of YouTube creators started with their phone. This can connect you with your audience. The right people will love you. You make the most money from this by recommending products or reviewing products and providing an affiliate link.

Some of the most popular channels will demonstrate products they bought of Amazon. The Affiliate program requires no special approval. There is free software out there for sharing

your screen if you are camera shy. You can even pay someone on Fiverr to make videos for you.



Sell Your Stuff – Not into creating content? No problem. You can always sell some of that junk around the house. You can sell old iPhones or even shoes. Sites like Decluttr can help you sell that old stuff at a profit. (Avoid old school sites like Ebay...)

This is the old one man's trash is another man's treasure. You may not need it anymore, but someone else might. The key is to get a good quality picture of the item and post a compelling description. Luckily, you can get a good quality picture with your phone these days.



Print on Demand - Are you creative? Even if you have no art skills you may come up with a funny t-shirt design. Sites like Printify and Zazzle allow you to sell your designs without having to hold inventory. They ship directly to your customer and only when an order is placed. If your shirt appeals to a certain group you can have conversations in Facebook groups and privately mention you have funny shirts. You may even be able to post memes in the group and then let people know they could be wearing your meme.

Warning! You do want to be VERY careful about legal issues here. I am not a lawyer and can't advise you on copyright law. You will want to do your own research, but

most images are copyright. Exercise caution and this could be your goldmine.



Affiliate Marketing – This appeals to a lot of people because there is a low barrier to entry. No product creation or customer service to worry about. If you don't like blogging or creating videos this can *still work* for you. You can find people in your niche on Facebook or other social media platforms. Then be helpful and provide quality information. On the back end recommend a product. Bonus Tip: if you use the product show your results.

Affiliate Marketing is one of the ways I have made millions online. It is really smart to collect leads and email them instead

of directly sending them to a sales page. This is one of the simplest ways to make quick cash online though.



Arbitrage – It may have a fancy name, but it works. Got no skills? No Creativity? Nothing to sell around the house? I STILL have you covered. Arbitrage just means you are a middleman. It is similar to Affiliate marketing. So, this works by going to site like Freelancer and offering a service at the going rate. But instead of doing it yourself, you hire someone at a site like Fiverr to do it cheaper. You just keep the difference.

For example, if you charge \$25 for the gig on Freelancer and pay \$5 to the guy on Fiverr you have made \$20 by

simply negotiating a better price. This method is scalable because you aren't doing the work yourself. You can hire as many people as necessary to do all the jobs you are given.



Social Media Manager – Do you post on social media? Are you skilled at typing something or making memes and then clicking post? Well, there are lots of businesses that hire someone to do just that. They are busy running the business and need someone else to post on social media for them. You can even use tools like Hootsuite to schedule these posts to go out on your different accounts.

Businesses need to be seen 24/7. But they can't be awake all that time. Some of them have no idea how to schedule content or even come up with ideas. You are already on Facebook all day anyway. So turn that into cash!

So, there you have it. 7 non-techy ways to make money online. These can get you some quick cash while you are going through my course.
